

Domestic Surcharges - Effective July 12, 2026

BILLING SURCHARGES	SURCHARGE AMOUNT	APPLICABLE MAIL CLASS	DESCRIPTION
Oversize	Zone Rate	Parcel Select, PRS, MM	The oversized price is applied on packages that are greater than 108 inches, but not more than 130 inches, in combined length and girth. Weight is not a factor as long as it does not exceed 70 pounds (no package can exceed 70 pounds). Oversize fees can be found in USPS Notice 123, in the Ground Advantage pricing section.
Dimensional Weight (DIM)	Zone Rate / Billed weight = higher between DIM weight and actual weight	Parcel Select, PRS, MM	When the DIM Weight applies, packages exceeding 1 cu ft (1,728 cubic inches) are priced at actual weight or calculated dimensional weight -- whichever is greater. 1. Multiply Length x Width x Height and divide by 139 to get the DIM weight in pounds. 2. If the DIM weight is greater than the actual package weight, you'll need to pay the DIM weight price. Example : You have a package that is 16" x 12" x 10" and weighs 5 lbs. Multiply length x width x height to get the volume of 1,920 cubic inches. That's larger than 1 cubic foot (1,728 cubic inches), so you must divide by 139 to find its DIM weight: 1,920 divided by 139 equals 13.92, which rounds up to 14 lbs. *DIM divisor changing from 166 to 139 on July 12, 2026
Parcel Dimensional Compliance	TBD - USPS	Parcel Select	Effective July 12, 2026, all parcels (boxes and polybags) should include accurate length, width, and height. Starting January 17, 2027, a USPS surcharge on shipments missing dimensional data will be applied. More information is available at the following link: Federal Register
Non-Standard Fee	\$17.00	Parcel Select	For any package exceeding 22" in length and/or over 2 cu ft, there will be an additional surcharge.
Delivery Area Surcharge (DAS)	\$1.75	Parcel Select	A flat DAS rate will apply to designated zip codes in extended or hard to reach areas. The UPS Mail Innovations DAS zip list can be found in the FAQ section of the following UPS link: DAS Zip Code List
Non-qualifying Mail Pieces	USPS Priority Rate plus 12% additional s	All product categories	A service charge of the USPS Priority Rate plus a 12% surcharge per piece will be billed to customer for all mail shipments ineligible for UPS Mail Innovations Services including nonqualified service code, non-qualified content, nonqualified physical characteristics, and nonqualified weights.
IMpb Label	\$0.25	Parcel Select, BPM, MM	This service charge will be billed for any packages which are not IMpb compliant.
Address Placement	USPS First Class Rate	Flats, BPM Flats	Mail Pieces not meeting USPS eligibility and address requirements for "Flat Mail" will be returned back to UPS-MI customer or billed at First Class pricing.
Fuel Surcharges (FSC)	12.00%	All product categories	FSC applies to the full billed amount. FSC can adjust monthly.
>10lb Weight Surcharge	\$2.00	Parcel Select, BPM, MM	For all outbound packages that weigh more than 10 pounds, a \$2.00 surcharge will be assessed.
Peak Surcharges	TBD	Parcel Select	USPS determines peak surcharge. 2026 peak surcharges have not been announced. In 2025, the peak surcharges were \$0.30 pp for all Parcel Select shipments.
EDZ delivered by USPS Surcharge	\$2.00	Parcel Select	Applies to EDZ packages that are turned over to USPS for final delivery
Hazmat Non-Compliance	\$50.00	Parcel Select	All hazardous materials and limited quantities (or Hazmat and Dangerous Goods) packages that don't meet the USPS guidelines for Hazmat or ORMd shipping, will incur a \$50.00 USPS surcharge. Please reference USPS Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, & Perishable Mail for more information.
APO/FPO/DPO & U.S. Territory Shipments	First Class Rate	Parcel Select, BPM, MM	Packages shipping to APO/FPO/DPO and U.S.Territories, must provide electronic CN22 information in compliance with USPS requirements. Failure to do so, may result in undelivered packages and First Class surcharges.
First Class Enclosure	\$0.72	Flats, Parcel Select, BPM, MM	Any package that contains content that is deemed First Class according to USPS guidelines, will incur this additional fee.

Postage Rates: Rates are subject to change. UPS-MI reserves the right to increase rates in the event of any increase in Postal Authority postage rates, and any such increase will be effective as of the date the Postal Authority postage rate change is placed into effect.

International Mail: UPS Mail Innovations International mail that is comingled within domestic mailings will be returned to sender. This is a change to the current domestic processes. Contact your respective sales representative to set up an international account so that we can service your international needs.

Hazmat Shipments: All hazardous materials and limited quantities (or Hazmat and Dangerous Goods shipments) require a separate Hazmat/ORMd contract with UPS Mail Innovations.

Customer Mis-sorts: If a customer mis-sorts any package to another carrier, these packages may get directly inducted into the USPS without ever making it into UPS Mail Innovations processing. This may lead to additional surcharges incurred from the USPS and Misc fees on your UPS Mail Innovations invoice.
