



## August 28, 2025 Update

### UPS Demand Surcharges<sup>1</sup>

One or more Demand Surcharges will apply to packages shipped during the specified Demand Periods (inclusive of any applicable starting and ending dates) for the origins, destinations, and service levels and in the amounts set forth below. Demand Surcharges apply in addition to all other applicable Charges.

Demand Surcharges are subject to change and Demand Periods may be extended or otherwise changed. Shippers should continue to check [ups.com/peaksurcharge](https://www.ups.com/peaksurcharge) for updates prior to tendering shipments.

#### A. Demand Surcharge – Applied to Additional Handling, Large Packages and Over Maximum

A Demand Surcharge will apply to packages that require Additional Handling<sup>2</sup> and Large Packages<sup>2</sup> for all U.S. domestic, U.S. import, and U.S. export shipments. A Demand Surcharge will apply to all packages that are Over Maximum Limits for all U.S. domestic, U.S. import, and U.S. export shipments. The Demand Surcharges will apply in the amounts set forth below.

## B. Demand Surcharge – Applied to UPS® Air, UPS® Ground Residential and UPS Ground Saver® Packages

A Demand Surcharge will apply to all UPS Air<sup>2</sup>, UPS Ground Residential<sup>2</sup> and UPS Ground Saver<sup>3</sup> packages:

For customers who are billed for more than 20,000 packages during any week following October 2024<sup>5</sup>, the Demand Surcharge schedule in the Higher Volume Shipper Tables will apply to certain UPS Air Residential<sup>2</sup>, UPS Air Commercial<sup>2</sup>, UPS Ground Residential<sup>2</sup> and UPS Ground Saver packages in lieu of the schedule listed above in Section B. The Demand Surcharge amounts in the Higher Volume Shipper Tables will apply on a weekly basis to each package based on the weekly volume for each service level as a percentage to the Baseline<sup>6</sup> for each week during the specified Demand Period. The highest applicable surcharge amount will apply to all packages in that week within each service level as determined by the weekly volume as a percentage of Baseline weekly average volume for any given week and service level.

<sup>5</sup> Applies to customers whose combined volume of Ground Residential, Ground Saver (formerly UPS SurePost), Next Day Air Residential and All Other Air Residential packages has exceeded 20,000 packages in any week after October 2024, regardless of the volume of customer's shipments for any particular service level. Once this aggregate threshold has been met, the Demand Surcharges apply until further notice to all service levels. The Demand Surcharges apply to all Ground Residential, Ground Saver, Next Day Air Residential and All Other Air Residential packages in any weekly invoice period for the applicable service level. For each service level each week, the amount of the surcharge for all packages for each service level is the highest applicable surcharge for the service level. For example, if the shipper has volume in a week of 175% of the Baseline average weekly volume for UPS Ground Residential, then each UPS Ground Residential package will be assessed a surcharge of \$2.70 (not just those over 150% of Baseline average weekly volume for UPS Ground Residential). For holiday weeks that are not full UPS operating weeks, the surcharge will apply to all packages in that weekly invoice period for the applicable service level multiplied by the number of full UPS operating days in that week. Customer's volume includes volume from any affiliated accounts and other accounts related to customer, as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion.

<sup>6</sup> The "Baseline" volume is the customer's average weekly volume for the applicable service level for June 2025 (June 1, 2025 through June 28, 2025). If customer's average weekly volume for the applicable service level from August 31, 2025 through September 27, 2025 is less than 80% of its average weekly volume from June 1, 2025 through June 28, 2025, as determined by UPS in its sole and unlimited discretion, then customer's average weekly volume from August 31, 2025 through September 27, 2025 will be used as the Baseline volume.
