The Australian Department of Agriculture , Fisheries and Forestry has introduced seasonal import measures to manage the risk of Brown marmorated stink bug (BMSB) during the high-risk season from September 1, 2022 until ATA Australia April 30,2023 (inclusive) All target high risk goods manufactured in or shipped from the target risk countries as sea cargo during the risk season must be treated (fumigated) by an approved treatment provider.
