



Import Duty Applied to All Imported Shipments in Thailand

Effective January 1, 2026, import duty will apply to all imported goods entering Thailand, including low-value goods, delivered through postal or courier services. Low-value goods are defined as those valued between THB 1 and THB 1,500 per package.

Under regulations prior to January 1, 2026, imported goods valued below THB 1,500 (de minimis) are exempt from import duty. However, effective January 1, 2026, the Thai Customs Department will begin charging import duty on goods valued from THB 1 to THB 1,500 per package. The import duty and value-added tax (VAT) applicable are calculated based on the tariff rate(s) of goods.

To expedite customs clearance, UPS may advance duty and taxes on a customer's behalf, but a Disbursement Fee will apply.
