### **Dangerous Goods System Preferences**

For Dangerous Goods shipments you may need to specify the following system preferences:

- Chemical Record data source (WorldShip software or an external source)
- Dangerous Goods documentation and printer options
- Export options for Dangerous Goods shipment information
- Custom label names for up to three record identifiers

# **Dry Ice**

How you process a Dry Ice shipment depends on if it is being used to cool other Dangerous Goods or non-Dangerous Goods.

If used to cool Dangerous Goods, Dry Ice (UN1845) should be selected as one of the three commodities in the package (see step 7 of Dangerous Goods Shipment Processing).

If used to cool non-Dangerous Goods, Dry Ice (UN1845) select the Dry Ice Package Option.
