



All Shipments in Thailand Containing Cannabis Subject to THB 30,000 per Kilogram Penalty

All shipments containing cannabis or cannabis flowers are prohibited from import, export, transit, or transshipment in Thailand.

Any such goods that are identified will be confiscated and forfeited by the State, and a penalty of THB 30,000 per kilogram will apply. For the purpose of assessing this penalty, any fractional weight will be rounded up to the next full kilogram. Any other costs incurred in handling the matter with the Customs Department will be charged directly to the shipper. This is pursuant to Thai Customs Department General Order No.9/2569.

The maximum fine is THB 500,000. Offenders may also face imprisonment of up to ten years, or both imprisonment and a fine.

In addition to the customs penalty above, an Unlawful Drug Fee of THB 34,558 per package may be imposed on the shipper. This fee (i) is in addition to any other charges or obligations owed to UPS in connection with the shipment or disposal of the unlawful drugs, all of which shall be borne by the shipper solely at its own risk and expense; and (ii) will be applied once the unlawful drugs have been seized or disposed of, as applicable.
