



New Export Permit Linking Requirement for Dual-Use Items, Effective July 30, 2026

Effective July 30, 2026, exporters of goods classified as Dual-Use Items (DUI) must electronically link the relevant license or certificate information through Thailand's **National Single Window (NSW) system** before submitting an export customs declaration.

DUI refer to goods capable of both commercial and military application. This requirement applies to shipments falling under any of the 342 Harmonized System (HS) codes classified as DUI and listed in [Thai Customs Announcement No. 85/2569](#), which sets out the Electronic Customs Procedures for linking information required under other laws relating to customs matters.

Exporters should obtain the necessary licenses or certificates and complete the required electronic linkage in the NSW system before initiating any export shipment from Thailand involving the applicable HS codes and product categories. Shipments that do not meet this requirement will not be cleared for export from Thailand.
